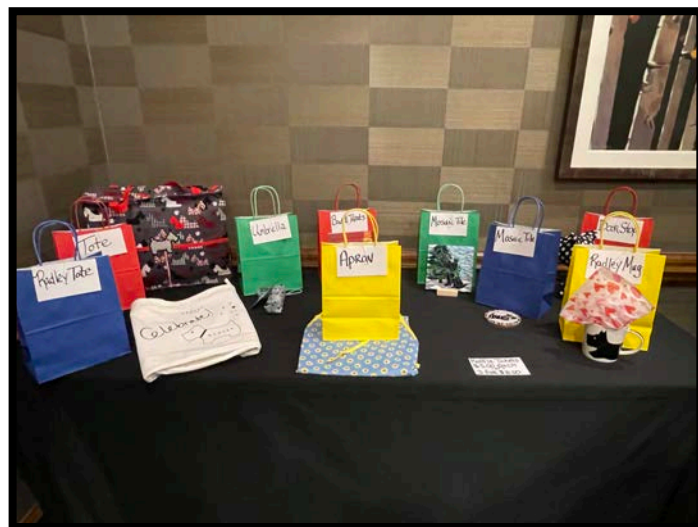
**Don Dieck:** Franklin of Troy continues steady progress up the Agility Competition Ladder. Franklin is now one level below Championship level.
